As we recently announced our newly 501 (c)(3) status back in November of 2021, we are delighted to also share with you that Merrimack Valley Black & Brown Voices has been awarded our first state grant of \$55,000 through the Massachusetts Executive Office of Housing and Economic Development (EOHED)'s Community Empowerment and Reinvestment Program.

"As the inaugural round of grant recipients demonstrates, the Community Empowerment and Reinvestment Grant Program is a powerful source of assistance to address a wide range of needs with specific solutions developed by community leaders, coalitions, and established organizations that are known to, and live among, the people and neighborhoods they serve," Lieutenant Governor Karyn Polito said at Thursday's announcement at UTEC in Lowell.

The Community Empowerment and Reinvestment Grant Program seeks to develop, strengthen, and invest in community-led efforts that are working to bring positive economic outcomes to communities that face historically disproportionate challenges to economic growth. Specifically, the program was developed to support communities with high rates of incarceration and/or recidivism, widespread poverty, and large groups of disadvantaged and underrepresented populations.
